terms & conditions

3. The patient may terminate this agreement by giving not less than one month's notice to The foot health clinic Ltd. The foot health clinic Ltd may terminate this agreement by giving the patient not less than one month's notice unless the patient has embarked upon a course of treatment that will take longer than one month, in which case the agreement will terminate upon the completion of the treatment.
- 3.1 In the event of the monthly charge being unpaid one month after it has become due, The foot health clinic Ltd may terminate this agreement by giving notice to the patient to that effect, effective from the last day on which a monthly charge was paid. The client will be liable for all monies outstanding and due to the foot health clinic at the date of and incurred after the date of termination.
4. The foot health clinic Ltd may increase the monthly fee for ORTHOPLAN/ PODPLAN on the 1st January each year and will give 2 months' notice of such an increase.
- 4.1 The patient agrees to pay The foot health clinic Ltd fee-per-item charges and the foot health clinic may increase the charges on the fee-per-item price list at any time. Any course of discounted treatment commenced before the increase will be charged at the original discounted price.
- 4.2 In the event that the patient terminates this agreement within twelve months of receiving discounted treatment or within twelve months from the end of a course of discounted treatment, the patient will be liable to refund The foot health clinic Ltd the full amount of the discount offered by The foot health clinic Ltd in relation
5. The monthly fee will be payable by Standing Order. The patient will pay the monthly fee until this contract is terminated. Annual fees may be paid by Debit Card, Cheque, Cash or by Standing Order. to the treatment or the course of treatment received.
6. The foot health clinic Ltd may alter the PODPLAN Priority Price List at any time.
- 6.1 PODPLAN Priority Price List Treatments are non-transferable and only available to the PODPLAN members
- 6.2 PODPLAN Priority Price List Treatments are subject to availability of therapists
- 6.3 PODPLAN Priority Price List Treatments can be booked by PODPLAN members only once the initial standing order payment has been received or upon payment of the annual fee
- 6.4 The Foot Health Clinic Ltd reserves the right to cancel any future PODPLAN Priority Pricelist Treatments in the event of non-payment of the contracted PODPLAN amount.
- 6.5 In the event of termination of the PODPLAN contract within the 12 month agreed period, The foot health clinic Ltd may request payment in respect of discounted treatments offered within the PODPLAN Priority Price List
7. The patient will:
 - 7.1 Attend the clinic when asked to do so for review or treatment purposes.
 - 7.2 Accept advice and recommendations from the health professional which safeguards the patient's general biomechanical and/or Podiatric wellbeing.
 - 7.3 Inform the health professional of any injury, difficulty or relevant matter affecting the patients's general biomechanical or Podiatric wellbeing
8. The patient consents to the disclosure of all of the patient's notes to members of The foot health Ltd clinic staff.
9. This agreement is exclusive to the patient and is not transferable between patients and does not cover the services of any other practice within The foot health clinic Ltd. This agreement may be transferred upon the sale of the practice to a new owner by notice in writing from a partner or the sole principal to the patient.
10. All notices given under the provision of this agreement must be in writing and sent to the last known address of the patient or the foot health clinic by recorded delivery post.
